SCORE KEEPER'S 11 COMMANDMENTS

1. Thou shalt not talk while keeping score; especially to the players while they are throwing.
2. Thou shalt not move about. Stand Still!
3. Thou shalt not look at a player when he/she is throwing. Face the chalk board.
4. Thou shalt not call out the score of darts, unless asked by the shooter.
5. Thou shalt not tell a shooter what to shoot for.
6. Thou shalt not tell a shooter what combination to shoot for.
7. Thou shalt not change a player's score if the opponent has begun to throw.
8. Thou shalt not lean out to see a dart, or follow the darts flight with either head or body movements.
9. Thou shalt not show any emotional displays while keeping score.
10. Thou shalt not accept a choice of score from any other player than the thrower. The thrower may consult with a partner.
11. Thou shalt not touch or manipulate a player's dart. A score keeper is to base their decisions on sight only.
